



Infant & Child Development Program

What is the Infant & Child Development Program?

The Infant and Child Development Program supports children, from birth to school entry, who have a developmental concern, developmental delay or an identified risk of delay. The program is family centred with support primarily in the home.

The Infant and Child Development Program offers a family centred approach identifying the child and family's strengths and needs. A Family Service Plan, in collaboration with the family, will be developed identifying the family's goals and addressing the child's developmental needs.

What we do:

- Support the child's development through informal and formal developmental screens and assessments
- Provide support to families through coaching and modeling
- Specific activities addressing the child's developmental needs
- Assistance to connect with other community services as needed, which could include, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech/language services, child care, and children's mental health.
- Information to access financial supports and funding as needed
- Transition to school support
