Infant & Child Development Program

What is the Infant & Child Development Program?

The Infant and Child Development Program supports children from birth to school entry, not attending a licensed childcare program, who have a developmental concern or developmental delay. The program is family centered and provides support using a routines based coaching approach.

The Infant and Child Development Program works with families to identify the child and family's strengths and needs. A Family Service Plan will be created identifying the family's goals and addressing the child's developmental needs.

What we do:

• Support the child's development through developmental screens and play based assessments.

- Provide support to families through coaching and modeling within their daily activities and routines.
- Specific activities addressing the child's developmental needs based on the family's goals.
- Assistance to connect with other community services as needed, which could include, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech/language services, child care, and children's mental health.
- Information to access financial supports and funding as needed
- Transition to school support
