This service is for children when there is a concern they are not meeting developmental milestones. That means they do not seem to learn skills when expected.

They are birth to school age. Service ends when they start school.

They live in Guelph Wellington.

They do not attend a licensed child care program.

- We assess a child's development.
- We help a caregiver understand their child's skills and needs.
- We share ways that a caregiver can support their child's development.
- We connect the family to additional services, assessments, and resources if needed.
