



# Supporting Kids in Camp (SKIC) Information for Families

## Who is this service for?

This service is for children and youth with two or more of the following:

- Physical challenges
- Cognitive challenges
- Behavioural challenges

They need one-to-one support to participate in a community day camp program.

They are under the age of 18 years at the start of camp. **They live in Guelph Wellington.**

The camps are in Guelph Wellington. They are committed to inclusion.

## What supports do we offer in this service?

- We provide a child/youth with a trained and experienced one-to-one worker at their camp.
- Support is limited to one week during the summer.
- The cost of camp is the sole responsibility of the family.  
There is no cost to the family for the SKIC Worker.

## How do I access this service?

1. First, register your child/youth in any day camp in Guelph Wellington.
2. Then, complete the application form and One Form found at [www.cmhaww.ca/skic](http://www.cmhaww.ca/skic).

If you need help with the application, you can ask someone who works with your child/youth.

3. Applications open April 1st.
