Supporting Kids in Camp (SKIC) Information for Families

Who is this service for?

This service is for children and youth with two or more of the following:

- Physical challenges
- Cognitive challenges
- Behavioural challenges

They need one-to-one support to participate in a community day camp program.

NEW: They are age 6 to under the age of 18 years at the start of camp.

They live in Guelph Wellington.

The camps are in Guelph Wellington. They are committed to inclusion.

What supports do we offer in this service?

- We provide a child/youth with a trained and experienced one-to-one worker at their camp.
- Support is limited to one week during the summer.
- The cost of camp is the sole responsibility of the family.
There is no cost to the family for the SKIC Worker.

How do I access this service?

1. First, register your child/youth in any day camp in Guelph Wellington.
2. Then, complete the application form found at www.cmhaww.ca/skic.

If you need help with the application, you can ask someone who works with your child/youth.

3. Applications open April 1st.
